3. Committee: Courts of Justice

4. Title: Juveniles; ages 11 through 13; released to detention home.

5. Summary: Provides that a juvenile between the ages of 11 and 13 who would ordinarily be punished for certain offenses in a correctional facility, may be released to a detention home or other juvenile facility if the operator of such facility notifies the court that they are capable and willing to accept juveniles between those ages.

6. No Fiscal Impact: PRELIMINARY.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Juvenile Justice, the proposed legislation is not expected to have a fiscal impact since the agency does not provide additional funding for post-disposition detention. In fact, 19 of 24 detention homes already have post-disposition programs which are operated on a local option.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Juvenile Justice, localities with juvenile detention homes
