4. Title: Selective service registration required for admission into Virginia's public colleges and universities.

5. Summary: This amendment requires that anyone failing to register for the Selective Service shall not be eligible for admittance to any state public institution of higher education.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate. (See Item 8.)

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: Public institutions would have to change their admission application process for applicants seeking admission to the college or university to include their selective service registration status and/or registration number. Current state law prohibits individuals who fail to register for the selective service from receiving state financial assistance. Verification of registration and the potential fiscal impact of increased staffing and expertise at the institution level to proactively comply with this legislation would vary by institution.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: All public colleges and universities.
