4. Title: **Learner's permits.**

5. Summary: Learner's permits. Prohibits issuance of learner's permits to minors when the records of the school they attend show they have had more than five unexcused absences from school in the six months immediately preceding their application.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: **Unknown.**

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: **No**

8. Fiscal Implications: While we cannot calculate the actual impact this bill would have on wait times or need for additional staff in DMV offices, it would add an additional step in the application process for a learner's and motorcycle learner's permit. Not addressed in the bill are such areas as home schooled students and compliance with this provision during periods of school recess.
