4. Title: School bus stop indicators.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation would provide that local school boards may install signs or other devices to indicate school bus stops. When the signs are installed on state-maintained highways, the signs are to first be approved by the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT). The school board is to maintain, repair and replace the signs. Wherever such signs or devices are so installed, VDOT shall use its best efforts to keep access to these areas unobstructed as the result of snow removal operations. The proposed legislation does not mandate the placement of signs at school bus stops, and provides that the installation of such signs does not designate the area as school property.

6. No Fiscal Impact: Final.

8. Fiscal Implications: VDOT is able to comply with the provisions of the proposed legislation with existing resources.
