5. Summary: Allows the holder of a limited mixed beverage restaurant license to sell and serve dessert wines as defined by the Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Board. This bill also contains an enactment clause that would require the ABC Board to promulgate regulations to implement the provisions of this act to be effective within 280 days of its enactment.
