## The substitute:

- Shifts the responsibility of connecting the felony misconduct to the person's covered employment from VRS to the employer.
- Clarifies that the identity of the employer for constitutional officers in the context of this legislation is the governing body of any locality served by the constitutional officer.
- Maintains an opportunity for judicial review of the employer's determination.
- Removes the reference to "future" benefits to cover situations where the felony misconduct is not discovered or prosecuted until after a person's retirement.
- Revises language regarding the Board's implementation of the employer's determination to allow VRS to process this type of matter within its ordinary course of business.

- Clarifies that any service credit lost under the statute may not be purchased at a later time.
- Removes the existing statutory language regarding loss of benefits to eliminate ambiguity and reduce the chance of confusion or misapplication.
