4. Title: **State Police Officers' Retirement System.**

5. Summary: State Police Officers' Retirement System. This legislation clarifies the time frame within which compulsory retirement for certain hazardous duty members shall occur. The proposed language would conform statute to current VRS Board of Trustees-approved policy by clarifying that compulsory retirement must take place within sixty (60) days of reaching the age of 70 years. Currently, the statute states that a member shall retire forthwith upon reaching the age of 70 years.
