**3. Committee:** Transportation

**4. Title:** Local vehicle licenses; agreements with DMV.

**5. Summary:** This bill provides that the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) will refuse registration or renewal of registration of a vehicle if any delinquent taxes, fines, or fees are owed to any county, city, or town, not just the county, city, or town that has entered into an agreement with DMV to deny registrations to persons who owe that particular locality these sources of revenues.

**6. No fiscal impact.**

**7. Budget amendment necessary:** No.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** Localities currently are able to put a “stop” on the registrations or registration renewals at the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) only on their own residents for failure to pay local licensing fees, personal property tax, or parking citations. This bill amends the Code so that one jurisdiction, having an agreement with DMV, may now request DMV to put a “stop” on a resident of another jurisdiction, if that resident owes these types of revenues to the jurisdiction.

**9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected:** Department of Motor Vehicles, Virginia counties, cities, and towns.
