Summary: Requires residential or day program, service or facility licensed or operated by any agency of the Commonwealth to report an outbreak of disease to the local health director or to the Commissioner of Health. This bill also authorizes the person in charge of any medical care facility, residential or day program, service or facility licensed or operated by any agency of the Commonwealth, day or residential program for children or adults licensed by the Department of Social Services, school, or summer camp as defined in §35.1-1 may also voluntarily report additional information, including individual cases of communicable diseases, at the request of the Department of Health for special surveillance or other epidemiological studies.
