4. Title: Water quality information.

5. Summary: This bill designates the Secretary of Natural Resources as the lead Secretary with the responsibility of coordinating technical assistance, information, and training to ensure that consistent water quality data is provided to the public. It also says that the Secretary shall consult with the Secretary of Agriculture and Forestry and the Secretary of Health and Human Resources in its cooperation with other agencies to develop and implement a program that monitors the water quality, habitat, and living resources of the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries.
