4. Title: Virginia Employment Commission orders.

5. Summary: The substitute bill authorizes final orders of the Virginia Employment Commission or circuit court allowing unemployment benefits to be recorded, enforced and satisfied as orders or decrees of a circuit court upon certification of such orders by the Commissioner of the Virginia Employment Commission or the court.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: The bill does not have a fiscal impact.

8. Fiscal Implications: None.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Virginia Employment Commission, circuit courts.

11. Other Comments: The substitute bill does not delete a provision that allows overpayments of unemployment benefits, with interest and fees and costs, to be collectible by civil action in the name of the employment commission.
