4. Title: Uniform Statewide Building Code; amusement devices; definitions.

Summary: Provides that the definition of “amusement device” shall not include any temporarily installed canopy, tent, or similar structure or inflatable device while in use for a private meeting or party limited in attendance to members of the organization sponsoring the event and invited guests.
