5. **Summary/Purpose:** Allows local salary supplements to be paid to local district court employees.

6. **No Fiscal Impact:** Indeterminate (see Item 8)

8. **Fiscal implications:** According to the Supreme Court of Virginia, there would be no fiscal impact to the court system for the costs that would be borne by any locality that would enact provisions to provide a supplement to district court employees. It is uncertain how many, if any, localities would potentially supplement local district court employees. Any funds received would need to be appropriated to the district courts in order to be spent. A budget amendment cannot be done at this time given that the revenue amount is indeterminate. Once revenues are determined, appropriation adjustments could be done either administratively or through amendments to the budget.
