5. Summary/Purpose:

The proposed legislation makes numerous technical changes to the list of offenses for which registration in the state's Sex Offender Registry (SOR) is required. The major changes are updates to the list of offenses covered so as to include offenses that were previously covered under different Code references.

8. Fiscal implications:

Although the proposed legislation seems to expand the list of offenses for which SOR registration is required, registration for those offenses is already implicitly required. Therefore, the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission has determined, pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, Code of Virginia, that the proposed legislation will have no impact on the need for prison bed space in the Commonwealth.
