5. Summary: Requires that each hearing be recorded separately, so that no more than one hearing is recorded per tape or other recording.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Supreme Court, anecdotal evidence suggests that, in many courts, hearings are currently being recorded in compliance with this legislation; therefore, the fiscal impact could be minimal for those courts. There are other courts currently recording a number of hearings on one tape so there will be some fiscal impact for the cost of additional tapes; however, the amount of the increase is indeterminate.
