- **8. Fiscal Implications:** The amounts shown include the salary (\$155,033), fringe benefits (\$91,283), substitute judge days (\$4,138) and equipment costs (\$2,500) per judgeship. An adjustment for one-time equipment costs has been factored into the calculations for the out years.

According to the Compensation Board, this legislation will also require twelve additional court security positions and six deputy clerks at a cost of \$537,887 per year.

Not included in the out year projection are any pay increases or increases in related benefit costs that may apply.
