4. Title: Virginia Indoor Clean Air Act; restaurants

5. Summary: Allows localities to adopt ordinances containing standards or provisions relating to smoking in restaurants that meet or exceed those established in the Virginia Indoor Clean Air Act.

8. Fiscal Implications: The fiscal impact of the legislation is unknown because it would allow cities to establish and implement their own ordinances relating to smoking in restaurants. Any costs or revenue resulting from the passing of this legislation would impact only cities that choose to adopt ordinances exceeding those established in the Virginia Indoor Clean Air Act.

The Department of Health currently inspects restaurants licensed by the Board of Health in fulfilling its responsibilities; therefore, the legislation would not have a fiscal impact upon the agency as it pertains to restaurant inspections.
