4. Title: **Inspection of food establishments; exception for private homes**

5. Summary: The bill exempts certain types of commercial food preparation in private homes from inspections by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. The exception will apply to candies, jams, and jellies not considered to be low-acid or acidified low-acid food products or baked goods that do not require time or temperature control after preparation, including cream pies, if such products: (i) are sold to an individual for his own consumption and not for resale and (ii) are labeled "NOT FOR RESALE—PROCESSED AND PREPARED WITHOUT STATE INSPECTION."
