4. Title: **Inspection of food establishments; exception for private homes**

5. Summary: The substitute bill exempts certain food preparations in private homes from inspections by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services if the food: (i) is sold to an individual for his own consumption; (ii) carries the label "NOT FOR RESALE—PROCESSED AND PREPARED WITHOUT STATE INSPECTION."

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: The bill does not have a fiscal impact.

8. Fiscal Implications: None.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.

11. Other Comments: The Senate substitute bill deletes, "sold at the private home or farmer's market" from the exemptions.
