Summary: Allows issuance of a driver's license to an applicant who fails to provide a social security number on the application if such failure is due to a bona fide religious objection to providing a social security number for any reason not related to official social security tax and/or benefit purposes.

8. Fiscal Implications: Revenue impact is unknown as DMV cannot forecast the changes that would be necessary to the DMV automated system if this bill is passed.
