4. Title: Virginia State University Board of Visitors

5. Summary: Expands the number of members to be appointed by the Governor to the Virginia State University's Board of Visitors from 11 to 15 members, establishes the term of office of the four additional members, and makes technical and clarifying amendments.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are: Preliminary. See Item 8.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation increases the membership of Virginia State University's Board of Visitors from 11 to 15 members. It is assumed these new members will be compensated pursuant to §23-3, Code of Virginia, which permits the reimbursement of any expenses incurred by members "in the discharge of their duties in attending the meetings of the board," so long as such expenses are properly itemized. These additional costs should be able to be absorbed within current resources of the university.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Virginia State University.

11. Other Comments: This bill is similar to HB513.
