- 8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Fire Programs currently receives one percent of the total direct gross premium on five lines of fire related insurance. This legislation would increase that amount by 0.5 percent for a total estimated increase of \$13.7 million each fiscal year. The Department of Fire Programs is required by \$38.2-401, Code of Virginia, to calculate 75 percent of all Fire Programs Funds revenue to allocate and distribute to the 324 jurisdictions as Aid to Localities and the remaining 25 percent makes up the agency's programmatic and administrative budget.
