4. Title: VPA police.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation would allow the Virginia Port Authority (VPA) to enter into agreements with localities in which VPA facilities are located to extend the jurisdiction of VPA police officers outside of the geographic boundaries of VPA property. The agreements would allow VPA police officers to travel beyond the property lines of Virginia Port Authority facilities in conducting their official duties. Current state law limits the jurisdiction of the Virginia Port Authority Police to property under control of the Port Authority.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Virginia Port Authority, cities of Norfolk, Newport News and Portsmouth, and Warren County.
