4. Title: Comprehensive Services Act; cost of services.

5. Summary: Adds data regarding the number of youth and families eligible for CSA-funded services, the type of services provided, and the cost of services to the list of data that the State Executive Council is required to collect and for which the State Executive Council is required to develop and implement data collection standards.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: None

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

8. Fiscal Implications: The Office of Comprehensive Services is currently in the process of developing and implementing uniform data collection standards, therefore the bill has no fiscal impact. However, requiring the collection of data regarding the number of children eligible for CSA services may not be feasible given the various criteria for CSA eligibility.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Office of Comprehensive Services

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: None

11. Other Comments: The Governor's introduced budget included \$277,000 for the purpose of developing a tool that will assist in the collection and analysis of such data as required by this bill.
