4. Title: **Alcoholic beverage control; mixing of wine, beer, and spirits for patrons.**

5. Summary: Adds definition for Sangria to list of alcoholic beverages; permits a licensee to make sangria that contains brandy, triple sec, or other similar spirits if prepared for a patron. The bill also restricts the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board from adopting regulations prohibiting any mixed beverage licensee from pre-mixing sangria in containers for purposes of sale and consumption upon the licensed premises. The bill also adds exclusions for when the licensee or any agent or employee of such licensee shall sell beer to which wine, spirits, or alcohol or both have been added.
