5. Summary: Provides that the moratorium on annexation proceedings does not end prior to the expiration of the 2008-2010 biennium if, for the 2008-2010 biennium, actual appropriations to local governments for law-enforcement expenditures are less than the amount statutorily required.

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed legislation does not have a fiscal impact.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Localities.

11. Other Comments: SB29 reduced the funding for the HB599 program by five percent, as provided for in the Governor's 2008 Budget Reduction Plan. SB30 caps the distribution to localities at the FY 2008 level.
