**4. Title:** Crimes Against Minors and Sex Offender Registry; use of data by SAVIN.

**5. Summary:** Allows the State Police to provide the Statewide Automated Victim Notification (SAVIN) system with Sex Offender Registry data in an electronic format to the Compensation Board for verification of registrant status and notification of victims and law enforcement.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** FINAL.

**7. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Department of State Police, any costs incurred due to the proposed legislation are expected to be minimal and can be absorbed using existing sex offender registry revenue. The Governor's introduced budget provided the Compensation Board the necessary support for the continued operations of the Statewide Automated Victim Notification (SAVIN) system. The House and Senate budgets kept or enhanced this funding.
