	A BILL to amend and reenact § 33.1-23.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to allocation of highway

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9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 33.1-23.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 33.1-23.1. Allocation of funds among highway systems.
12	A. The Commonwealth Transportation Board shall allocate each year from all funds made available
13 14	for highway purposes such amount as it deems reasonable and necessary for the maintenance of roads within the interstate system of highways, the primary system of state highways, the secondary system of
15	state highways and for city and town street maintenance payments made pursuant to § 33.1-41.1 and
16	payments made to counties which have withdrawn or elect to withdraw from the secondary system of
17	state highways pursuant to § 33.1-23.5:1. However, notwithstanding any contrary provision of law,
18	beginning with fiscal year 2010, the Commonwealth Transportation Board shall determine highway
19	maintenance and operational needs by highway system, by highway construction district, and by locality.
20	To the extent such highway maintenance and operational needs are not addressed by revenues from the
21 22	Highway Maintenance and Operating Fund, the Commonwealth Transportation Board shall allocate
$\frac{22}{23}$	additional funds for maintenance and operational purposes from the highway share of the Transportation Trust Fund in the following manner:
23 24	1. Unmet Interstate Highway System maintenance and operational needs shall be addressed by
25	deducting sufficient federal funds from the Interstate Highway System construction program, first as
26	authorized by federal law, and then in accordance with § 33.1-23.2.
27	2. Unmet state primary highway system maintenance and operational needs shall be addressed by
28	deducting sufficient funds from each highway construction district in accordance with § 33.1-23.2 to
29 30	address the unmet maintenance and operational needs of that same highway construction district.
30 31	3. Unmet state secondary highway system maintenance and operational needs shall be addressed by deducting sufficient funds from each county's allocation, as determined by § 33.1-23.4, to address the
32	unmet maintenance and operational needs of that same county.
33	4. Unmet urban highway system maintenance and operational needs of cities and towns as defined in
34	§ 33.1-23.2 and those unmet maintenance and operational needs of counties that have withdrawn or
35	elect to withdraw from the state secondary highway system shall be addressed by deducting sufficient
36	funds from each allocation received as determined by §§ 33.1-23.3 and 33.1-23.5:1, respectively.
37 38	B. After funds are set aside for administrative and general expenses and pursuant to other provisions
30 39	in this title which provide for the disposition of funds prior to allocation for highway purposes, and after allocation is made pursuant to subsection A of this section, the Commonwealth Transportation Board
40	may allocate each year up to 10% of the funds remaining for highway purposes for the undertaking and
41	financing of rail projects that, in the Board's determination, will result in mitigation of highway
42	congestion. After the forgoing allocations have been made, the Board shall allocate the remaining funds
43	available for highway purposes, exclusive of federal funds for the interstate system, among the several
44 45	highway systems for construction first pursuant to §§ 33.1-23.1:1 and 33.1-23.1:2 and then as follows:
4 5 46	1. Forty percent of the remaining funds exclusive of federal-aid matching funds for the interstate system shall be allocated to the primary system of state highways, including the arterial network, and in
47	addition, an amount shall be allocated to the primary system as interstate matching funds as provided in
48	subsection B of § 33.1-23.2.
49	2. Thirty percent of the remaining funds exclusive of federal-aid matching funds for the interstate
50	system shall be allocated to urban highways for state aid pursuant to § 33.1-44.
51 52	3. Thirty percent of the remaining funds exclusive of federal-aid matching funds for the interstate
52 53	system shall be allocated to the secondary system of state highways. C. In addition, the Commonwealth Transportation Board, from funds appropriated for such purpose
55 54	in the general appropriation act, shall allocate additional funds to the Cities of Newport News, Norfolk,
55	and Portsmouth and the County of Warren in such manner and apportion such funds among such
56	localities as the Board may determine, unless otherwise provided in the general appropriation act. The
57	localities shall use such funds to address highway maintenance and repair needs created by or associated
58	with port operations in those localities.

D. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this section, the General Assembly may, through the general appropriations act, permit the Governor to increase the amounts to be allocated to highway maintenance, highway construction, either or both. 59 60

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
