2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 46.2-743 of the Code of Virginia, relating to special license plates for*
3 *veterans of Operation Iraqi Freedom.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 46.2-743 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 46.2-743. Special license plates for certain veterans; fees.

9 A. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an honorably discharged
10 former member of one of the armed forces of the United States, the Commissioner shall issue to the
11 applicant special license plates.

12 B. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
13 been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the
14 United States Marine Corps, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose
15 design incorporates an emblem of the United States Marine Corps. Unremarried surviving spouses of
16 persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license
17 plates under this subsection.

18 C. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
19 been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the
20 United States Army, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose design
21 incorporates an emblem of the United States Army.

22 D. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of World War II,
23 the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of World War II. For each set of license
24 plates issued under this subsection, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of
25 state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued.

26 E. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Korean
27 War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Korean War.

28 F. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Vietnam
29 War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Vietnam War.

30 G. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the
31 Asiatic-Pacific Campaign, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of that
32 campaign. For each set of license plates issued under this subsection, the Commissioner shall charge, in
33 addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are
34 issued.

35 H. *On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation*
36 *Iraqi Freedom, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of Operation Iraqi*
37 *Freedom.*

38 I. The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and B 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued
39 under subsection A, D, E, ~~or~~ F, *or* H of this section.
