WHEREAS, the Kilmarnock-Lancaster Volunteer Rescue Squad is commended on the occasion of its 50th anniversary; and

WHEREAS, in 1957, the community recognized the need for a rescue squad, and the Kilmarnock-Lancaster Volunteer Rescue Squad was organized; and

WHEREAS, today, the Kilmarnock-Lancaster Volunteer Rescue Squad is located near Rappahannock General Hospital; and

WHEREAS, the Kilmarnock-Lancaster Volunteer Rescue Squad serves the citizens of Kilmarnock, White Stone, Irvington, and the lower parts of Lancaster and Northumberland Counties; and

WHEREAS, the Kilmarnock-Lancaster Volunteer Rescue Squad has grown to a dedicated 25-member squad that provides emergency medical care and transport; and

WHEREAS, providing life-saving services to the community, the Kilmarnock-Lancaster Volunteer Rescue Squad answers 750 to 1,000 calls annually; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby commend and congratulate the Kilmarnock-Lancaster Volunteer Rescue Squad on the occasion of its 50th anniversary; and, be it
