WHEREAS, in February 1999, Cheryl Stevens began working for the Navy's Bureau of Medicine and Surgery at the Naval Hospital in Camp Lejeune as a department head in the Management Analysis Department of the Comptroller's Division; and

WHEREAS, in November 2000, Cheryl Stevens went to work for the Chief of Naval Operations, and she retired as an invaluable project manager for the Navy's Defense Travel System; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly commend Cheryl L. Stevens on her 35 years of dedication and exceptional public service to the Commonwealth and the nation; and, be it
