4. Title: Hampton Roads Transportation Authority.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation would abolish the Hampton Roads Transportation Authority (the Authority) and the taxes, fees, and charges dedicated to financing its operation and programs.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.

8. Fiscal Implications: House Bill 3202 of the 2007 General Assembly session created the Hampton Roads Transportation Authority and identified several transportation projects the Authority was to construct with its revenue stream. That revenue stream was ruled unconstitutional by the Virginia Supreme Court in February 2008. This bill would abolish the Authority.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Hampton Roads Transportation Authority, cities and counties in Hampton Roads, Department of Transportation
