3. Committee: House Transportation

4. Title: Issuance of requests for proposals under PPTA for Hampton Roads highway projects.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation would require the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), within 90 days, to issue requests for proposals under the Public-Private Transportation Act of 1995 (PPTA) for five specific projects in Hampton Roads.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.

8. Fiscal Implications: The legislation would require VDOT to solicit PPTA proposals regardless of the status of the projects in the federally required National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process, including public input and involvement. It would also modify existing policy on the composition of the review panel for the proposals excluding independent technical expertise.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Transportation, localities in Hampton Roads

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: None.
