4. Title: Vehicle titles

5. Summary: This bill provides that in titling vehicles brought into Virginia from another state, the person applying for a Virginia title for any such vehicle need not present a title issued by the other state if the laws of that other state do not require the vehicle to be titled in that state. The second enactment clause specifies that the bill is in force on passage.

6. No fiscal impact. Final.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: This bill would require the Department of Motor Vehicles to research the titling laws of other states and retain such information in its Vehicle Licensing Guide. No fiscal impact is anticipated.
