**4. Title:**         **Certificate of free sale; Department of Health.**

**5. Summary:** Authorizes the Commissioner of Health, or her designee, to continue to issue a certificate of free sale to any manufacturer, located in Planning District 11, of any product defined as a “cosmetic” in the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act, 21 U.S.C. 301, to allow the export of such products. Such certificates will only be issued to a manufacturer that has regularly received certificates of free sale from the Department of Health for at least 25 years. This bill contains an emergency clause, and expires on July 1, 2009.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** Based on the legislation, only one manufacturer would be eligible to receive certificates of free sale from the Virginia Department of Health. The fiscal impact upon the department for issuing certificates of free sale to the manufacturer is unknown.
