An Act to amend and reenact § 46.2-931 of the Code of Virginia, relating to distribution of handbills, etc., solicitation of contributions, and sale of merchandise on highways. regulating:

VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

7 1. That § 46.2-931 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 8

§ 46.2-931. Certain localities may prohibit or regulate distribution of handbills, etc., solicitation of 9 contributions, and sale of merchandise on highways within their boundaries.

10 A. Arlington and, Hanover, Henrico, and Spotsylvania Counties, the City Cities of Richmond and Falls Church, and the Town of Vienna are hereby authorized to adopt ordinances prohibiting or 11 12

1. The distribution of handbills, leaflets, bulletins, literature, advertisements, or similar material to the 13 14 occupants of motor vehicles on highways located within their boundaries;

15 2. The solicitation of contributions of any nature from the occupants of motor vehicles on highways located within their boundaries; and 16

3. The sale of merchandise or the attempted sale of merchandise to the occupants of motor vehicles 17 18 on highways located within their boundaries.

B. Albemarle, Hanover, Spotsylvania, and Greene Counties, and the City Cities of Richmond and 19 Falls Church are hereby authorized to adopt ordinances regulating: 20

21 1. The distribution of handbills, leaflets, bulletins, literature, advertisements, or similar material to the 22 occupants of motor vehicle vehicles on public roadways and medians;

23 2. The solicitation of contributions of any nature from the occupants of motor vehicles on public 24 roadways and medians; and

25 3. The sale of merchandise or the attempted sale of merchandise to the occupants of motor vehicles 26 on public roadways and medians.

27 C. Ordinances adopted pursuant to this section may provide that any person violating the provisions 28 of such ordinances shall be guilty of a traffic infraction.

29 D. The Virginia Department of Transportation may regulate activities within such streets and highways under its jurisdiction, subject to regulations promulgated by the Commonwealth Transportation 30 31 Board. Nothing in this section shall be construed to allow any locality to permit activities within any highway under the maintenance and operational jurisdiction of the Virginia Department of 32
