8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 54.1-703.3 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 54.1-703.3. Waiver of examination; estheticians.
11	The Board shall waive the examination requirements for licensure as an esthetician or master
12	esthetician for any individual who (i) makes application for licensure between July 1, 2007, and before
13	July [1, 2008 2010 30, 2009]; (ii) otherwise complies with Board regulations relating to moral
14	turpitude; and (iii) meets any of the following conditions:
15	1. Has at least three years of documented work experience as an esthetician or a master esthetician
16	that is deemed satisfactory by the Board;
17	2. Has completed a training program that is deemed satisfactory by the Board; or
18	3. Holds an unexpired certificate of registration, certification, or license as an esthetician or a master
19	esthetician issued to him on the basis of comparable requirements by a proper authority of a state,
20	territory, or possession of the United States, or the District of Columbia.
21	2. That an emergency exists and this act is in force from its passage.
22	3. That the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation shall [, to the extent
23	reasonably practicable. I provide widespread potification to those affected by the provisions of this
