9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 46.2-857 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 46.2-857. Driving two abreast in a single lane.
12	A person shall be guilty of reckless driving who drives any motor vehicle, including any motorcycle,
13	so as to be abreast of another vehicle in a lane designed for one vehicle, or drives any motor vehicle,
14	including any motorcycle, so as to travel abreast of any other vehicle traveling in a lane designed for
15	one vehicle. However, [ nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit two motorcycles from
16	traveling abreast while traveling in a lane designated for one vehicle. In addition, ] this section shall not
17	apply to any validly authorized parade, motorcade, or motorcycle escort, nor shall it apply to a motor
18	vehicle traveling in the same lane of traffic as a bicycle, electric personal assistive mobility device,
10	alerthic menual provided biometers and an encoded of Network that any discussion of this section it shall be a

electric power-assisted bicycle, or moped. [Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, it shall be a traffic infraction punishable by a \$25 civil penalty for two motorcycles to travel abreast in a lane designed for one vehicle.] 19 20 21
