11	1. That §§ 2.2-426, 2.2-428, and 2.2-431 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as
12	follows:

14	A. Each lobbyist shall file a separate annual report of expenditures, including gifts, for each principal
15	for whom he lobbies by July 1 for the preceding 12-month period complete through April 30.
16	B. Each principal who expends more than \$500 to employ or compensate multiple lobbyists shall be
17	responsible for filing a consolidated lobbyist report pursuant to this section in any case in which the
18	lobbyists are each exempt under the provisions of subdivision 7 or 8 of § 2.2-420 from the reporting
19	requirements of this section.
20	C. The report shall be on a form provided by the Secretary of the Commonwealth, which shall be
21	substantially as follows and shall be accompanied by instructions provided by the Secretary.

Each lobbyist shall send to each legislative and executive official who is required to be identified 466 467 by name on Schedule A or B of the Lobbyist's Disclosure Form a copy of Schedule A or B or a 468 summary of the information pertaining to that official. Copies or summaries shall be provided to the 469 official by December 15 for the preceding 12-month period complete through November 30. 470 § 2.2-428. Standards for automated preparation and transmittal of lobbyists' disclosure statements; 471 database. 472 A. The In lieu of a hard copy, the Secretary shall accept any lobbyist's disclosure statement required 473 by § 2.2-426 filed by computer or electronic means in accordance with the standards approved by the 474 Secretary and using software meeting standards approved by the Secretary. The Secretary may provide 475 software to filers without charge or at a reasonable cost. The Secretary may prescribe the method of 476 execution and certification of electronically filed statements and the procedures for receiving statements 477 in the office of the Secretary. 478 B. The Secretary shall establish a lobbyist disclosure database, available to the public, from required 479 disclosure statements filed electronically and may enter into that database information from required 480 disclosure statements filed by other methods. 481 § 2.2-431. Penalties; filing of substituted statement. 482 A. The lobbyist shall sign the disclosure statement prescribed by § 2.2-426 attesting to its completeness and accuracy. The Secretary shall review each statement for completeness and accuracy 483 **484** and if a statement is not properly completed, the entire filing shall be rejected and returned to the lobbyist. The lobbyist shall submit a revised statement within 10 working days from receipt of the 485 486 returned statement. 487 B. Every lobbyist failing to file the statement prescribed by § 2.2-426 within the time prescribed 488 therein shall be assessed a civil penalty of fifty dollars, and every individual failing to file the statement within ten days after the time prescribed herein shall be assessed an additional civil penalty of fifty 489 490 dollars per day from the eleventh day of such default until the statement is filed. The penalties shall be 491 assessed and collected by the Secretary. The Attorney General shall assist the Secretary in collecting the 492 penalties, upon request. B.C. Every lobbyist's principal whose lobbyist fails to file the statement prescribed by § 2.2-426 shall 493 494 be assessed a civil penalty of fifty dollars, and shall be assessed an additional civil penalty of fifty 495 dollars per day from the eleventh day of such default until the statement is filed. The penalty shall be 496 assessed and collected by the Secretary. The Attorney General shall assist the Secretary in collecting the 497 penalties, upon request. 498 C.D. No individual who has failed to file the statement required by § 2.2-426 or who has failed to 499 pay all penalties assessed pursuant to this section, shall register or act as a lobbyist as long as he 500 remains in default. 501 D-E. Whenever any lobbyist is or will be in default under § 2.2-426, and the reasons for such default 502 are or will be beyond his control, or the control of his principal, or both, the Secretary may suspend the assessment of any penalty otherwise assessable and accept a substituted statement, upon the submission 503 504 of sworn proofs that shall satisfy him that the default has been beyond the control of the lobbyist or his 505 principal, and that the substituted statement contains the most accurate and complete information 506 available after the exercise of due diligence. 507 E F. Penalties collected pursuant to this section shall be payable to the State Treasurer for deposit to 508 the general fund.
