| 6 | A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Chapter 15 of Title 63.2 an article numbered 6, |
| 7 | consisting of a section numbered 63.2-1530, relating to the Virginia Child Protection Accountability |

| 9 | Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: |
| 10 | 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 15 of Title 63.2 an article |
| 11 | numbered 6, consisting of a section numbered 63.2-1530 as follows: |
| 12 | Article 6. |
| 12 13 | Virginia Child Protection Accountability System. |
| 14 | § 63.2-1530. Virginia Child Protection Accountability System. |
| 15 | A. The Virginia Child Protection Accountability System (the System) is created to collect and make |
| 16 | available to the public information on the response to reported cases of child abuse and neglect in the |
| 17 | Commonwealth. The Department shall establish and maintain the System. The Board shall promulgate |
| 18 | regulations to implement the provisions of this section. |
| 19 | B. The following information shall, notwithstanding any state law regarding privacy or confidentiality |
| 20 | of records, be included in the System and made available to the public via a website maintained by the |
| 21 | Department and in print format: (i) the total number of complaints alleging child abuse, neglect, or a |
| 22 | combination thereof received, (ii) the total number of complaints deemed valid pursuant to § 63.2-1508, |
| 23 | (iii) the total number of complaints investigated by the Department pursuant to subsection I of |
| 24 | § 63.2-1503 and § 63.2-1505, (iv) the total number of cases determined to be founded cases of abuse or |
| 25 | neglect, and (v) the total number of cases resulting in a finding that the complaint was founded |
| 26 | resulting in administrative appeal. Information reported pursuant to (v) above shall be reported by total |
| 27 | number of appeals to the local department, total number of appeals to the Department, and total |
| 28 | number of appeals by outcome of the appeal. For each category of information required by this |
| 29 | subdivision, the Department shall also report the total number of cases by type of abuse; by gender, |
| 30 | age, and race of the alleged victim; and by the nature of the relationship between the alleged victim |
| 31 | and alleged abuser. |
| 32 | C. Data collected pursuant to subsection B shall be made available to the public on a website |
| 33 | established and maintained by the Department and shall also be made readily available to the public in |
| 34 | print format. Information included in the System shall be presented in such a manner that no individual |
| 35 | identifying information shall be included. |

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
