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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 2.2-1504 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 2.2-1504. Estimates by state agencies of amounts needed.
13	A. Biennially in the odd-numbered years, on a date established by the Governor, each of the several
14	state agencies and other agencies and undertakings receiving or asking financial aid from the
15	Commonwealth shall report to the Governor, through the responsible secretary designated by statute or
16	executive order, in a format prescribed for such purpose, an estimate in itemized form in accordance
17	with the expenditure classification adopted by the Governor, showing the amount needed for each year
18	of the ensuing biennial period beginning with the first day of July. The Governor may prescribe targets
19	that shall not be exceeded in the official estimate of each agency; however, an agency may submit to
20	the Governor a request for an amount exceeding the target as an addendum to its official budget
21	estimate.
22	B. Each agency or undertaking required to submit a biennial estimate pursuant to subsection A shall
23	simultaneously submit an estimate of the amount that will be needed for the two succeeding biennial
24	periods beginning July 1 of the third year following the year in which the estimate is submitted. The
25	Department shall provide, within thirty days following receipt, copies of all agency estimates provided
26	under this subsection to the chairmen of the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate
27	Committee on Finance.
28	C. The format used in making these estimates shall (i) be prescribed by the Governor, shall (ii) be
29	uniform for all agencies, and (iii) clearly designate the kind of information to be given. The Governor
30	may prescribe a different format for estimates from institutions of higher education, which format shall
31	be uniform for all such institutions and shall clearly designate the kind of information to be provided.
32	C. The Department shall provide copies of all agency estimates submitted under subsection B and
33	prepare an analysis of such estimates for the deliberative use of the Governor and the General
34	Assembly, such analysis to include, but not be limited to, (i) appropriations requested as compared to
35	the prior year, (ii) a brief description of each agency's priorities for receiving funding, and (iii) a
36	discussion of major changes or initiatives recommended for the ensuing fiscal year. The Department
37	shall submit the estimates and analysis to the Governor and, within 30 days thereof, submit the same to
38	the chairmen of the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance.

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
