59 limited in scope as provided in a home inspection contract, provided such contract is not inconsistent 60 with the provisions of this chapter or the regulations of the Board. 61 "Certified home inspector" means a person who meets the criteria of education, experience, and testing required by this chapter and regulations of the Board and who has been certified by the Board. 62 63 "Dust clearance sampling" means an on-site collection of dust or other debris that is present after 64 the completion of a renovation to determine the presence of lead-based paint hazards and the provisions 65 of a report explaining the results. "Dust sampling technician" means an individual licensed by the Board to perform dust clearance 66 67 sampling. 68 Friable" means that the material when dry, may be crumbled, pulverized or reduced to powder by hand pressure and includes previously nonfriable material after such previously nonfriable material 69 becomes damaged to the extent that when dry it may be crumbled, pulverized, or reduced to powder by 70 71 hand pressure. "Lead abatement" means any measure or set of measures designed to permanently eliminate 72 lead-based paint hazards, including lead-contaminated dust or soil. 73 74 "Lead-based paint" means paint or other surface coatings that contain lead equal to or in excess of 75 1.0 milligrams per square centimeter or more than 0.5 percent by weight. "Lead-based paint activity" means lead inspection, lead risk assessment, lead project design and 76 77 abatement of lead-based paint and lead-based paint hazards, including lead-contaminated dust and 78 lead-contaminated soil. 79 "Lead-contaminated dust" means surface dust that contains an area or mass concentration of lead at 80 or in excess of levels identified by the Environmental Protection Agency pursuant to § 403 of TSCA (15 U.S.C. § 2683). 81 "Lead-contaminated soil" means bare soil that contains lead at or in excess of levels identified by the 82 83 Environmental Protection Agency. "Lead contractor" means a person who has met the Board's requirements and has been issued a 84 license by the Board to enter into contracts to perform lead abatements. 85 "Lead inspection" means a surface-by-surface investigation to determine the presence of lead-based 86 87 paint and the provisions of a report explaining the results of the investigation. 88 "Lead inspector" means an individual who has been licensed by the Board to conduct lead 89 inspections and abatement clearance testing. 90 "Lead project design" means any descriptive form written as instructions or drafted as a plan 91 describing the construction or setting up of a lead abatement project area and the work practices to be 92 utilized during the lead abatement project. "Lead project designer" mean an individual who has been licensed by the Board to prepare lead 93 94 project designs. 95 "Lead risk assessment" means (i) an on-site investigation to determine the existence, nature, severity and location of lead-based paint hazards and (ii) the provision of a report by the individual or the firm 96 conducting the risk assessment, explaining the results of the investigation and options for reducing 97 98 lead-based paint hazards. 99 "Lead risk assessor" means an individual who has been licensed by the Board to conduct lead 100 inspections, lead risk assessments and abatement clearance testing. "Lead supervisor" means an individual who has been licensed by the Board to supervise lead 101 102 abatements. "Lead worker" or "lead abatement worker" means an individual who has been licensed by the Board 103 104 to perform lead abatement. "Person" means a corporation, partnership, sole proprietorship, firm, enterprise, franchise, association 105 or any other individual or entity. 106

107 "Principal instructor" means the individual who has the primary responsibility for organizing and
 108 teaching an accredited asbestos training course or program, an accredited lead training course or both
 109 program, an accredited renovation training program, or any combination thereof.

"Renovation" means the modification of any existing structure or portion thereof, for compensation,
that results in the disturbance of painted surfaces, unless that activity is performed as a part of a lead
abatement. As used in this definition, "compensation" shall include (i) pay for work performed, such as
that paid to contractors and subcontractors; (ii) wages, including but not limited to those paid to
employees of contractors, building owners, property management companies, child-occupied facilities
operators, state and local government agencies, and nonprofit organizations; and (iii) rent for housing
constructed after January 1, 1978, or public or commercial building space.

117 "Renovation contractor" means a person who has met the Board's requirement and has been issued a
 118 license by the Board to conduct renovations.

119 "Renovator" means an individual who has been issued a license by the Board to perform renovations
120 or to direct others who perform renovations.

121 "Residential building" means, for the purposes of home inspection, a structure consisting of one to 122 four dwelling units used or occupied, or intended to be used or occupied, for residential purposes.

123 "Training manager" means the individual responsible for administering a training program and 124 monitoring the performance of instructors for an accredited asbestos training or an accredited lead 125 training program or both.

126 § 54.1-500.1. Virginia Board for Asbestos, Lead, and Home Inspectors; membership; meetings; 127 offices; quorum.

128 The Virginia Board for Asbestos, Lead, and Home Inspectors shall be appointed by the Governor and 129 composed of ten 13 members as follows: one shall be a representative of a Virginia-licensed asbestos 130 contractor, one shall be a representative of a Virginia-licensed lead contractor, one shall be a 131 representative of a Virginia-licensed renovation contractor, one shall be either a Virginia-licensed 132 asbestos inspector or project monitor, one shall be a Virginia-licensed lead risk assessor, one shall be a 133 Virginia-licensed renovator, one shall be a Virginia-licensed dust sampling technician, one shall be a 134 representative of a Virginia-licensed asbestos analytical laboratory, one shall be a representative of an 135 asbestos and, lead, or renovation training course provider, two shall be certified home inspectors and 136 two shall be citizen members. Of the 1994 appointments, the terms shall be as follows: one member 137 shall serve a term of two years, and one member shall serve a term of four years. Of the 2001 home 138 inspector appointments, the terms shall be as follows: one home inspector shall serve a three year term, 139 and one home inspector shall serve a four-year term. Thereafter, After initial staggered terms, the terms 140 of members of the Board shall be four years, except that vacancies may be filled for the remainder of 141 the unexpired term. The initially appointed representatives of the lead industry shall be deemed to be 142 certified upon having completed lead training offered at an Environmental Protection Agency Regional 143 Training Center. The two home inspector members appointed to the Board shall have practiced as home 144 inspectors for at least five consecutive years immediately prior to appointment. The renovation 145 contractor, renovator, and dust sampling technician members appointed to the board shall have 146 practiced respectively as a renovation contractor, renovator, or dust sampling technician for at least five 147 consecutive years prior to appointment. Each home inspector appointment to the Board may be made 148 from nominations submitted by the National Association of Home Inspectors and the American Society 149 of Home Inspectors, who may each nominate no more than three persons for each home inspector 150 vacancy. In no case shall the Governor be bound to make any appointment from such nominees. Home 151 inspector members shall not vote on any matters before the Board except matters related to home 152 inspectors until July 1, 2003.

153 The Board shall meet at least four times each year and other such times as it deems necessary. The 154 Board shall elect from its membership a chairman and a vice-chairman to serve for a period of one year. 155 Six Seven members of the Board shall constitute a quorum. The Board is vested with the powers and 156 duties necessary to execute the purposes of this chapter.

157 § 54.1-501. Powers and duties of the Board. 158

The Board shall administer and enforce this chapter. The Board shall:

159 1. Promulgate regulations necessary to carry out the requirements of this chapter in accordance with 160 the provisions of the Administrative Process Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq.) to include but not be limited to the 161 prescription of fees, procedures, and qualifications for the issuance and renewal of asbestos and, lead, 162 and renovation licenses, and governing conflicts of interest between among various categories of 163 asbestos and, lead, and renovation licenses;

164 2. Approve the criteria for accredited asbestos training programs, accredited lead training programs, 165 accredited renovation training programs, training managers, and principal instructors;

3. Approve accredited asbestos training programs, accredited lead training programs, accredited 166 167 renovation training programs, examinations and the grading system for testing applicants for asbestos 168 and lead, and renovation licensure;

169 4. Promulgate regulations governing the licensing of and establishing performance criteria applicable 170 to asbestos analytical laboratories;

171 5. Promulgate regulations governing the functions and duties of project monitors on asbestos projects, 172 circumstances in which project monitors shall be required for asbestos projects, and training 173 requirements for project monitors;

174 6. Promulgate, in accordance with the Administrative Process Act, regulations necessary to establish 175 procedures and requirements for the: (i) approval of accredited lead training programs, (ii) licensure of 176 individuals and firms to engage in lead-based paint activities, and (iii) establishment of standards for 177 performing lead-based paint activities consistent with the Residential Lead-based Paint Hazard Reduction 178 Act and United States Environmental Protection Agency regulations. If the United States Environmental 179 Protection Agency (EPA) has adopted, prior to the promulgation of any related regulations by the Board, 180 any final regulations relating to lead-based paint activities, then the related regulations of the Board shall not be more stringent than the EPA regulations in effect as of the date of such promulgation. In 181

182 addition, if the EPA shall have outstanding any proposed regulations relating to lead-based paint activities (other than as amendments to existing EPA regulations), as of the date of promulgation of any 183 184 related regulations by the Board, then the related regulations of the Board shall not be more stringent 185 than the proposed EPA regulations. In the event that the EPA shall adopt any final regulations subsequent to the promulgation by the Board of related regulations, then the Board shall, as soon as 186 187 practicable, amend its existing regulations so as to be not more stringent than such EPA regulations; and

188 7. Promulgate regulations for certification of home inspectors not inconsistent with this chapter 189 regarding the professional qualifications of home inspectors applicants, the requirements necessary for 190 passing home inspectors examinations in whole or in part, the proper conduct of its examinations, the proper conduct of the home inspectors certified by the Board, the implementation of exemptions from 191 192 certifications requirements, and the proper discharge of its duties; and

193 8. Promulgate, in accordance with the Administrative Process Act, regulations necessary to establish 194 procedures and requirements for the (i) approval of accredited renovation training programs, (ii) 195 licensure of individuals and firms to engage in renovation, and (iii) establishment of standards for 196 performing renovation consistent with the Residential Lead-based Paint Hazard Reduction Act and 197 United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulations. Such regulations of the Board shall 198 be consistent with the EPA Lead, Renovation, Repair, and Painting Program final rule. 199

§ 54.1-503. Licenses required.

200 A. It shall be unlawful for any person who does not have an asbestos contractor's license to contract 201 with another person, for compensation, to carry out an asbestos project or to perform any work on an asbestos project. It shall be unlawful for any person who does not have an asbestos project designer's license to develop an asbestos project design. It shall be unlawful for any person who does not have an 202 203 204 asbestos inspector's license to conduct an asbestos inspection. It shall be unlawful for any person who 205 does not have an asbestos management planner's license to develop an asbestos management plan. It 206 shall be unlawful for any person who does not have a license as an asbestos project monitor to act as 207 project monitor on an asbestos project.

208 B. It shall be unlawful for any person who does not possess a valid asbestos analytical laboratory 209 license issued by the Board to communicate the findings of an analysis, verbally or in writing, for fee, 210 performed on material known or suspected to contain asbestos for the purpose of determining the 211 presence or absence of asbestos.

212 C. It shall be unlawful for any person who does not possess a license as a lead contractor to contract 213 with another person to perform lead abatement activities or to perform any lead abatement activity or 214 work on a lead abatement project. It shall be unlawful for any person who does not possess a lead 215 supervisor's license to act as a lead supervisor on a lead abatement project. It shall be unlawful for any 216 person who does not possess a lead worker's license to act as a lead worker on a lead abatement project. 217 It shall be unlawful for any person who does not possess a lead project designer's license to develop a 218 lead project design. It shall be unlawful for any person who does not possess a lead inspector's license to conduct a lead inspection. It shall be unlawful for any person who does not possess a lead risk 219 assessor's license to conduct a lead risk assessment. It shall be unlawful for any person who does not 220 221 possess a lead inspector's or lead risk assessor's license to conduct lead abatement clearance testing.

222 D. It shall be unlawful for any person who does not possess a license as a renovation contractor to 223 perform renovation. It shall be unlawful for any person who does not possess a renovator's license to 224 perform or direct others to perform renovation. It shall be unlawful for any person who does not 225 possess a dust sampling technician's license to perform dust clearance sampling. 226

§ 54.1-512. Exemptions from licensure.

227 A. In an emergency that results from a sudden unexpected event that is not a planned renovation or 228 demolition, the Board may, at its discretion, waive the requirement for asbestos contractor's, supervisor's 229 and worker's licenses.

230 B. Any employer, and any employee of such employer, who conducts an asbestos project on 231 premises owned or leased by such employer shall be exempt from licensure.

232 C. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Virginia Tort Claims Act (§ 8.01-195.1 et seq.), neither the 233 Commonwealth nor any agency or employee of the Commonwealth shall be subject to any liability as 234 the result of a determination made by the Board hereunder.

D. Nothing in this chapter shall be construed as requiring the licensure of a contractor who contracts 235 236 to undertake a project, a portion of which constitutes an asbestos or lead abatement project or 237 renovation, if all of the asbestos or lead abatement work or renovation is subcontracted to a person 238 licensed to perform such work in accordance with the provisions of this chapter.

239 E. This chapter shall not apply to any person who performs lead-based paint activities within residences which they own, unless the residence is occupied by a person or persons other than the 240 owner or the owner's immediate family while these activities are being conducted or a child is residing 241 242 in the property and has been identified as having an elevated blood-lead level.

243 F. This chapter shall not apply to renovations of owner-occupied housing constructed before 1978, provided the person performing renovations obtains a statement signed by the owner providing that (i)
no child under the age of six or pregnant woman resides in the structure, (ii) the residence is not a
child-occupied facility, and (iii) the owner acknowledges that renovations may not include all of the
lead-safe work practices contained in the EPA Lead, Renovation, Repair, and Painting Program final
rule.

G. This chapter shall not apply to any person who performs renovations on (i) housing constructed
after January 1, 1978, (ii) housing for the elderly or persons with disabilities, unless a child under the
age of six resides or is expected to reside in the structure, or (iii) a structure that does not have
bedrooms.

§ 54.1-516. Disciplinary actions.

A. The Board may reprimand, fine, suspend or revoke (i) the license of a lead contractor, lead
inspector, lead risk assessor, lead project designer, lead supervisor, lead worker, asbestos contractor, asbestos supervisor, asbestos inspector, asbestos analytical laboratory, asbestos management planner, asbestos project designer, asbestos project monitor or, asbestos worker, *renovator, dust sampling technician, or renovation contractor* or (ii) the approval of an accredited asbestos training program, accredited renovation training program, training manager or principal
instructor, if the licensee or approved person or program:

261 1. Fraudulently or deceptively obtains or attempts to obtain a license or approval;

262 2. Fails at any time to meet the qualifications for a license or approval or to comply with the263 requirements of this chapter or any regulation adopted by the Board; or

3. Fails to meet any applicable federal or state standard when performing an asbestos project or
 service or, performing lead-based paint activities, or performing renovations.

B. The Board may reprimand, fine, suspend or revoke the license of, (i) any asbestos contractor who employs or permits an individual without an asbestos supervisor's or worker's license to work on an asbestos project Θr , (ii) any lead contractor who employs or permits an individual without a lead supervisor's or lead worker's license to work on a lead abatement project, or (iii) any renovation contractor who employs or permits an individual without a renovator's license to perform or to direct others who perform renovations.

272 C. The Board may reprimand, fine, suspend or revoke the certification of a home inspector.

273 § 54.1-517. Penalties for willful violations.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any person who willfully violates any provision of this
chapter or any regulation related to licensure or training adopted pursuant to this chapter shall be guilty
of a Class 1 misdemeanor for the first two violations and a Class 6 felony for a third and each
subsequent violation within a three-year period.

278 In addition, licensed asbestos contractors, asbestos supervisors, asbestos inspectors, asbestos management planners, asbestos project designers, asbestos project monitors, asbestos analytical laboratories and asbestos workers, lead contractors, lead inspectors, lead risk assessors, lead project 279 280 281 designers, lead supervisors, lead workers, renovators, dust sampling technicians, renovation contractors, 282 and accredited asbestos training programs, accredited lead training programs, accredited renovator 283 training programs, training managers or principal instructors may be assessed a civil penalty by the 284 Board of not more than \$1,000 for an initial violation and \$5,000 for each subsequent violation within a 285 three-year period arising from a willful violation of standards established by the Environmental 286 Protection Agency, Occupational Safety and Health Administration, Department of Labor and Industry, 287 or the Divisions of Air Pollution Control and Waste Management of the Department of Environmental 288 Ouality in a three-year period.

289 2. That the initial appointments of the members in accordance with this act shall be staggered as 290 follows: one member for a one-year term, one member for a two-year term, and one member for a 201 three year term

292 3. That the members appointed in accordance with this act shall not vote on any matters before 293 the Board for Asbestos, Lead, and Home Inspectors except on matters related to renovations as

294 defined in § 54.1-500 until the effective date of the regulations promulgated pursuant to this act.
