11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That § 4 of Chapter IV, as amended, § 1 of Chapter XVIII, as amended, and § 1 of Chapter
13 14	XXII of Chapter 431 of the Acts of Assembly of 1950 are amended and reenacted and that Chapter XXIII of Chapter 431 of the Acts of Assembly of 1050 is amended by adding sections
14 15	Chapter XVIII of Chapter 431 of the Acts of Assembly of 1950 is amended by adding sections numbered 2 and 3 as follows:
16	Chapter IV
17	Council
18	§ 4. Election and terms of president (ex officio mayor), vice-president (ex officio vice-mayor) and
19	members of boards and commissions; quorums; journal; etc. (a) On the first Tuesday in July next
20	following the regular municipal election, or as soon thereafter as may be practicable, the newly elected
21	council shall proceed to choose by majority vote of all the members thereof one of their number to be
22	president, who shall be ex officio mayor, and another as vice-president, who shall be ex officio
23	vice-mayor, of the council, each of whom shall serve for a period of two years from the first day of the
24 25	July in which such election is held and until their successor or successors have been elected and qualified.
2 6	(b) Appointment of boards and commissions; enumeration, term. The school board, library board, and
27	dock commission shall each consist of five members-; provided, however, that in the event the council
28	elects to participate in a regional free library system in lieu of establishing a local library board as
29	provided for in Chapter XXII, Section 1, the council shall appoint such members of the board of such
30	regional free library system as are permitted under the inter-jurisdictional contract establishing the
31	regional library system as that contract may be amended from time to time.

revenue anticipation obligations that mature within one year from the date of their issue. Such bonds soexcepted may be issued upon an affirmative vote of a majority of all members of city council.

61 § 3. The issuance, execution, and terms of such bonds shall be governed by Chapter 26 (§ 15.2-2600 62 et seq.) of Title 15.2, of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended.

65 § 1. ThereAt the election of city council, shall be (i) a library board of the City of Hopewell which 66 that shall consist of five members, who shall be residents of the City of Hopewell, who shall be

appointed by a majority of the city council as hereinbefore provided, whose qualifications shall be such and who shall perform such duties as the city council may prescribe-, or (ii) the City of Hopewell shall

69 join and participate in a regional free library system pursuant to §§ 42.1-37 to 42.1-45, inclusive, of the

70 Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended.
