10 11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 17 of Title 58.1 an article
12	numbered 8, consisting of sections numbered 58.1-1731, 58.1-1732, and 58.1-1733, as follows:

14	Digital Media Fee
15	§ 58.1-1731. Fee for digital media purchase or rental.
16 17	There is hereby imposed a fee equal to 10 percent of the price of all in-room purchases or rentals of disital modia in botals models, bad and breakfast establishments imposed other facilities offering quest
17 18	digital media in hotels, motels, bed and breakfast establishments, inns, and other facilities offering guest rooms rented out for continuous occupancy for fewer than 30 consecutive days.
19	§ 58.1-1732. Collection.
20	The fee imposed by this article shall be collected monthly by the Department of Taxation in the same
21	manner as the sales and use tax imposed under Chapter 6 (§ 58.1-600 et seq.), as provided by rules and
22	regulations promulgated by the Tax Commissioner.
23	§ 58.1-1733. Disposition of proceeds.
24 25	After the administrative costs for collecting the fees are recovered by the Department of Taxation, the remaining revenues shall be divided as follows:
2 6	1. Fifty percent shall be deposited into the state's general fund; and
27	2. Fifty percent shall be deposited into a special fund created hereby and known as the Film
28	Incentive Programs Fund (the Fund). All revenues in the fund shall be used for film incentive programs
29	established by the Virginia Film Office.
