11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-36.3 as follows:
12	§ 18.2-36.3. Unintentionally causing miscarriage or stillbirth; penalty.
13	A. Any person who, while engaged in conduct so gross, wanton, and culpable so as to show a
14	reckless disregard for the life or safety of others, causes injury to another person who is pregnant and
15	that injury results in a miscarriage or stillbirth, is guilty of a Class 5 felony.
16	B. When the injury described in subsection A is caused by a person (i) under the influence of an
17	illegal Schedule I or II controlled substance, marijuana, or alcohol, (ii) while operating a motor vehicle
18	when his license is suspended pursuant to § 18.2-266, 18.2-266.1, 46.2-301, or 46.2-357, or (iii) while
19	committing an act in violation of § 18.2-57.2, such person is guilty of a Class 4 felony.
20	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or

commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and cannot be determined for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice. 21 22 23
