10 11 12	WHEREAS, according to the Virginia Department for the Aging, the number of older adults is rising rapidly, particularly Virginians age 85 and older, who as a group will increase five times faster than the state's total population between 1990 and 2025; and
13 14 15	WHEREAS, studies show a critical need for additional mental health services for older people with major psychiatric illnesses now and an expectation that the need will more than double over the next 25 years; and
16 17 18	WHEREAS, according to a 2006 estimate of the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission, close to 282,000 older Virginians suffered from a mental disorder in 2000, and a significant number of such cases were not treated, resulting in high costs; and
19 20 21	WHEREAS, the combination of geriatric inpatient-unit downsizing, the increasing dual diagnoses of psychiatric illness and dementia in older adults, and the difficulties faced by long-term care facilities and community-based programs in serving this population calls for immediate attention by policymakers,
22 23 24 25 26 27 28	practitioners, and the public; and WHEREAS, State Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services Board policy "recognizing the prevalence of mental illness, [intellectual disabilities] and substance use disorder diagnoses among older adults, the growing numbers of these older adults, and the specialized needs of this population, encourage[s] and support[s] the development of high quality, accessible, responsive and effective services for these older adults"; and WHEREAS, older adults benefit from a mental health system that promotes recovery,
