098688472 **HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 756** 1 2 Offered January 19, 2009 3 Encouraging the Secretary of Transportation to establish a Virginia Association of Metropolitan 4 Planning Organizations. 5 Patron-Cosgrove 6 7 Referred to Committee on Transportation 8 9 WHEREAS, there are 14 Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPO) operating in the 10 Commonwealth of Virginia, all duly established pursuant to federal transportation legislation, 23 C.F.R. 450.300 series; and 11 WHEREAS, these MPO organizations are especially important in that, pursuant to federal legislation, 12 they are, as the lead agencies, responsible for conducting the cooperative metropolitan transportation 13 planning and programming process in their respective regions; and 14 WHEREAS, the transportation planning and programming decisions made by these MPO 15 organizations presage the future investment and expenditure of tens of millions of dollars of public 16 moneys on an annual basis; and 17 WHEREAS, while each of these MPO organizations is necessarily independent, whether they are 18 large or small MPOs, they have numerous common interests at both the policy and technical levels, and 19 20 they each seek to interpret and adhere to the requirements of the same federal legislation; now, 21 therefore, be it 22 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly 23 recognizes the need for and encourages the Secretary of Transportation to establish a Virginia 24 Association of Metropolitan Planning Organizations (VAMPO) to augment, not supplant, the duties of 25 the individual MPOs in carrying out their respective metropolitan transportation planning and programming functions; and, be it 26 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Secretary of Transportation shall determine the scope of VAMPO 27 28 activities and responsibilities best suited to the professional needs of the Commonwealth of Virginia or 29 adopt other measures to enhance the effectiveness, professionalism and confidence of the state's MPO 30 organizations; and, be it

RESOLVED FINALLY, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare of copy of this resolution
for presentation to the Chair and the Executive Director of each of the state's MPO organizations that, in
turn, requests their organization's inputs and recommendations for this state association of MPOs
concept.
