## **HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 780**

3 Commending the American Cancer Society.

6 WHEREAS, the American Cancer Society is the nationwide, community-based organization dedicated
7 to eliminating cancer as a major health problem; through research, education, advocacy, and services, the
8 organization is determined to prevent cancer, save lives, and diminish suffering; and

9 WHEREAS, cancer is the second leading cause of death in the United States, and one in every four 10 deaths in the United States is from cancer; and

11 WHEREAS, an estimated 565,650 Americans died from cancer last year, which is more than 1,500 people per day; and an estimated 35,590 new cases of cancer were diagnosed in Virginia in 2008; and

13 WHEREAS, major scientific breakthroughs in the last 15 years have changed the way we think about 14 cancer; and

WHEREAS, today, 65 percent of people diagnosed with cancer will survive the disease for at leastfive years; and

17 WHEREAS, communities all across the Commonwealth will celebrate life and the prevention of
18 cancer by participating in American Cancer Society Day in Virginia on February 5, 2009; now,
19 therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly
 21 commend the American Cancer Society for its outstanding contributions to the fight against cancer in
 22 the Commonwealth; and, be it

23 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution24 for presentation to the American Cancer Society as an expression of the General Assembly's gratitude to

25 the organization for its dedication to the health and well-being of all Virginians.
