WHÊREAS, Laura Marshall is a Social Studies Lead Teacher, serves as a mentor and colleague to new teachers in Chesterfield County, is a member of Grange Hall School's Strategic Management Team and Curriculum Academy, and serves as the school's public relations liaison; and

WHEREAS, Laura Marshall attended and graduated from the public schools of Reston and earned both bachelor of science and master of education degrees, the latter *cum laude*, in Early Childhood Education, from Virginia Tech; and

WHEREAS, Laura Marshall is a devoted wife to husband Adam and mother to two young children, Ryan and Katelyn; now, therefore, be it
