WHEREAS, known for her compassion for people and animals, Ethel Beun founded a homeless cat shelter known as King Street Cats that rescues about 250 cats each year; and she donated the second floor of her business building for the organization's mission; and

WHEREAS, Ethel Beun was an active member of Arlington Metaphysical Chapel and enjoyed yoga and other exercise activities; and

WHEREAS, a loving and lively woman, Ethel Beun will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by her devoted husband, Jim Logan; her daughter, Jennifer Rohrbach; her son, Brian Beun, Jr.; her two stepsons, Jim Logan, Jr., and David Logan; her seven grandchildren; and many other loving family members and friends; now, therefore, be it
